SUMMARY OF COMMITTEE MEETING

The committee met on 2/9/2022.

2022 CapX and Major Projects:

 The committee received an update from staff on the status of the CapX and Major Projects list and discussed projects impacted by supply chain issues and product cost increases.

Veterans Serenity Walk:

 Per Board direction, the committee revisited the proposed Veterans Serenity Walk concept to gather more information. Staff briefed the committee on conversations with California Construction Authority (CCA) and reviewed the LOU outlining estimated costs for engaging CCA in working with a landscape architect to develop three design concepts, one at the \$300,000 level, one at \$400,000 and one at \$500,000. The item is on the February Board agenda for further discussion.

Draft Master Site Plan Concept:

OPER Board direction, the committee discussed the proposed Agriplex concept included in the draft Master Site Plan concept and is recommending that further discussion take place at the March Board meeting when all Board members participate in a phase-by-phase review of the draft Master Site Plan concept.

Equestrian Center

 The committee is also recommending that a discussion regarding next steps for the equestrian center take place at the March Board meeting during the draft Master Site Plan concept discussion.

Other

Staff provided information related to the condition of Building 15 which has continued to deteriorate and has sustained additional damage from recent rain and wind storms. In addition, the review of the building determined the outside wall material contains asbestos which would require abatement if any work is to proceed. Staff is developing a scope of work and cost estimates. The committee is also recommending that Building 15 be a part of the draft Master Site Plan concept discussion at the March Board meeting.
