



The Contractor will comply, and will require its subcontractors to comply, with all federal, state and local statutes, laws, ordinances and regulations governing Concessionaire's business, including, but not limited to recycling laws and requirements, environmental laws, ordinances, and regulations, South Coast Air Quality Management District regulations, and Regional Water Quality Control Board Regulations. The Contractor shall to the best of its ability conduct its business in compliance with the Clean Air Act, The Clean Water Act, the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Act, the California Environmental Quality Act, the National, Environmental Protection Act, and all comparable, related, and successor statutes, laws, ordinances, and regulations applicable to Master Concessionaire.

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY
