Santa Ana Pavilion Breezeway: Exhibitor must provide materials to construct booth. Tents are not allowed. Pipe frame may be used; pipes must be covered. Exhibitor may order directly from, and pay the pipe and drape rental fee to, OC Fair's supplier. Contact the Commercial and Concessions Department for contact information. FOOD CONCESSIONS SPACE RATES

A guarantee of \$3,000 for carts and \$6,500 for all other food stands versus 25% of gross sales; whichever is greater.

Food stands consist of mobile food kitchens; tents or food trucks are not allowed for food sales.
