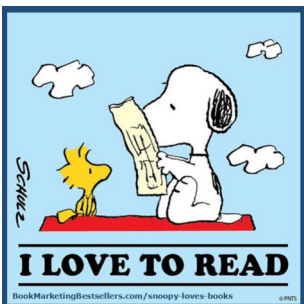

General Information

DROP - OFF & PICK - UP

- **Drop Off;** Parents must drive to the upper parking lot (only) for drop off and pick up.
- Parents will walk students to the gate.
- Staff at gate will greet and usher students into school.
- Students who have siblings in the preschool must drop and pick up from the lower parking lot only. (Park on the street).
- Preschool staff will greet students and usher preschool & elementary students into school.
- **Pick Up;** Parents will park (upper parking lot) and use walkway to walk up to the gate. Staff will use Walkie Talkies to have students come to gate for dismissal.
- Please call the office if any adult (other than those on the Application form) arrives to pick up your child.
- We will not release your child to anyone who is not on the emergency pick up form.

WHAT CHILDREN NEED EVERY DAY

- Lunch & snack (disposable items are highly recommended)
- We are unable to warm up any lunches.
- Water fountains are turned off. We like to request that all students bring non disposable water bottles to school.
- A backpack with lunch, snacks (for morning and afternoon), non-disposable water bottles are preferred to reduce waste.
- Backpacks will be kept inside school lockers.
- Sunscreen (applied at home) & cap or hat.
- Athletic shoes. **No sandals**, as students will be involved in lots of outdoor games and activities.



On Very Hot days

- When temperature exceeds 90 Degrees, children will stay indoors.
- When there is a lot of smog or smoke from fires, children will stay indoors.
- Children may go outside to play in the late afternoon when temperatures are cooler.
- They will be encouraged to play in the shade under the trees or under the patio.
