How Does it Work


- Referral: If you think your child may need support, contact your local school or districts special education department.
- Assessment: With your consent, your child may be evaluated to determine their needs based off of suspected disability.
- 3. **IEP Meeting**: A team- including parent/guardian-will meet to decide eligibility and services based on the students assessment results.
