Helpful Tips for a Successful Year



Elementary

- Start the day off by; waking up early, eating a healthy breakfast, getting back pack ready with school essentials, wearing the school uniform and getting to school on time.
- TK & K will start each school day at **9:00 a.m.** and end at 3:00 p.m.
- 1st - 5th graders will start each school day at **8:30 a.m.** and end at 3:00 p.m.
- All students must adhere to the Behavior Contract that will be addressed in school and sent home for parents as well. We ask that parents please support us by making sure children adhere to it without compromise so that the school environment is conducive to learning.
- IXL & Google Classroom are our internet platforms this school year. Students in 1st – 5th grade will have homework that has to be completed on a laptop/iPad at home.
- Students in 1st - 5th must bring a laptop/tablet/iPad to school. Days to be announced.
- Language/Literature, Math, Geometry, History, Geography, Botany & Zoology are the 7 core subjects that students will be graded on each semester with a grade key of A,B,C and 1,2,3.
- Special Subjects such as Science, Social Studies, PE, Spanish, Art, Music, STEM, IT Class will be graded with a key: VG, G, A, N/I.
- Students must complete all class curriculum requirements in order to graduate & move onto the next grade.

SEPARATION

- ❖ Separation anxiety is a normal stage of development. Tears are expected from our little ones. Our teachers are loving, nurturing and experienced in helping your child develop a positive attitude about school.
- ❖ A positive conversation about the drop off procedure with all positives/lots of encouragement must be **done at home** prior to coming to school. It helps!
- ❖ Before arriving at gate, be sure to give hugs & kisses, say good-bye & clearly state that you will be back for pick up.
- ❖ Please do not send any comfort items to school
- ❖ Good-byes should be brief, positive, affectionate and consistent.
