Passing through The Paseo, take note of the shops used in one of the scenes of this 2007 romantic comedy starring Seth Rogen, Jason Segal, and Katherine Heigl in which Ben and Allison go shopping for baby stuff.

Another Sting scene, the bank pops up in the beginning when Henry Gondorff (Newman) is shown getting together a team of people to help exact revenge on Doyle Lonnegan (Shaw). On Colorado head east and make a left on Euclid.

Changeling

This location was graced by the famous actress and filmmaker Angelina Jolie in 2008 in this mystery crime drama. It's the church of Briegleb, the crusading priest.



Cruel Intentions

This church, with its unique architectural detail, can also be seen in the 1999 romantic teen drama starring Sarah Michelle Gellar, Ryan Phillippe, and Reese Witherspoon. In this scene, Kathryn finally gets her comeuppance at Sebastian's memorial service.



Legally Blonde

You can also catch a glimpse of All Saints in this 2001 comedy romance. The film is set at Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts, but most of the filming is actually in L.A. The Gothic Harvard square is the rector's house.



The scene is the one in which Wendy corners Mr. Nottingham, and tries to convince him to build his new hotel somewhere else, to save the school.



The Big Bang Theory

Does the dome look familiar? That's because it's the view just outside Sheldon and Penny's apartment from one of the most successful sitcoms ever, starring Jim Parsons, Howard Wolowitz, and Kaley Cuoco.



Beverly Hills Cop II

Yes, it's the Beverly Hills Police Station! Beverly Hills is the establishing shot, but the scenes with actors were filmed here.



Mission Impossible (1966 TV series)

It is an embassy in this action spy series starring with such actors as Leonard Nimoy, Greg Morris and Sam Elliot.



A Walk In The Clouds

This iconic building was used to depict a Napa Valley town square in this romantic drama. The entire movie was filmed in Napa Valley wineries however; the climatic wine festival scene takes place in none other than City Hall's courtyard.



The Great Dictator 1940

If you feel like you're in a palace when strolling these halls, you're not wrong! It's the Palace of Adenoid Hynkel one of Hollywood's most significant films and Charlie Chaplin's first sound picture and Oscar-nominated film.



Parks and Recreation

As versatile as this building is, it's an actual city hall on NBC'S political satire mockumentary sitcom television series, starring actors Chris Pratt, Aubrey Plaza, and Amy Poehler. You may recognize it as Pawnee City Hall.

Remember the San Francisco party scene in this 2005 romantic comedy? Don't be fooled! The shindig attended by Beau and Sarah, AKA Kevin Costner and Jennifer Aniston, actually takes place in the courtyard. More filming was done in a nearby Pasadena home.

B Memorial Park

Arrested Development -

You may recall the scene in which George Sr. runs through the park in this primetime Emmy Award winning comedy series in which he tries to escape. Starring Will Arnett, Jason Bateman, Michael Cera, etc.

1600 Penn

At the very end of the pilot episode of this TV series you'll spot this location as the restaurant where President Dale Gilchrist (Bill Pullman) takes his family to dinner AKA a Washington D.C. pizza joint. This location was also an actual restaurant for about 30 years starting in 1984. Head west towards Kendall Alley, make a left at Kendall and walk to Union Street.



D 41 Union Street (Kendall Alley)

Live Free or Die Hard

This unassuming alley can be spotted in the 2007 action thriller and fourth installment of the Die Hard film series. In this scene, John McClane (Bruce Willis) calls FBI Deputy Director Miguel Bowman (Cliff Curtis), in an alley where he and Thomas see the fake White House explosion on a television through a restaurant window. Head west across Fair Oaks Avenue and make a left at Smith Alley.

The Sting

Smith Alley, another notable passageway made famous in this 1973 caper film starring Robert Redford, Paul Newman, Robert Shaw, and Charles Durning. In this scene, Johnny Hooker (Redford) and Luther Coleman (Robert Earl Jones) swindle the mob courier. Continue south until you reach Colorado Blvd and cross De Lacey diagonally.

Father of the Bride (1991)

Scene where father of the bride, George Banks (Steve Martin) and groom, Bryan MacKenzie (George Newbern) are having drinks at Club 41. Head south and make a left on Green Street.

Native Pasadenans may remember this former flower shop! It is also a flower shop in this 2007 romance comedy starring John Krasinski, Robin Williams, and Mandy Moore. The flower shop is Moore's character's place of



employment. Head east and make a right at



The Little Rascals

Castle Green is a common filming site for some of Hollywood's most iconic films. You'll recognize this as the site where Spanky takes Alfalfa to Darla's ballet recital, where he insists Alfalfa break up with her. The boys also flee the property to escape bullies.



The Last Samurai

Tom Cruise fans, you're in luck! A scene of this 2003 action flick was filmed inside the Castle Green's Moorish Room; however, it was portrayed as the restaurant in which Nathan Algren (Cruise) is introduced to Omura, a Japanese businessman.

Buffy the Vampire Slayer

Given the size of the Castle Green apartments, you won't be surprised to hear that it is used for the exterior shots of the Glorificus' mansion in this supernatural drama television series starring Sarah Michelle, Alyson Hannigan, and David Boreanaz.

Bugsy

This building returned to its roots as it was depicted as a Cuban Resort Hotel in this 1991 crime drama starring Warren Beatty, Annette Bening, and Harvey Keitel.



The Prestige

Similarly, the building is used as a hotel in the 2006 mystery film starring Hugh Jackman, Christian Bale, and Michael Cain.



The Sting

Last but not least, Redford and Newman also filmed here. The lounge was the plush 'New York' gambling casino and the corridors were that of the 'Chicago' hotel. Continue east on Green Street.
