




ICE SKATING CENTER

NASA – JPL tested two robot prototypes at PISC. These robots will use lasers to map lava tubes and caves on the Moon and Mars that will provide a natural and safe habitat for astronauts in the next decade. They needed a white, reflective, icy surface (similar to the Moon) to test the mobility and laser accuracy of the robots. They plan to return for more testing in the future.
