Tourism Trends and Market Insights

The PCVB attended the Los Angeles Outlook Forum which shared the latest industry trends, hotel and tourism market insights. Some insights include a focus on wellness, unique culinary experiences, shopping tourism, micro-trips and bleisure. The US economy is heading towards a slow down or recession in 2020. International travel is slowing especially because of the strong dollar. Long-haul domestic travel is driving tourism growth. In Los Angeles, new hotel supply continues to grow with 107 new properties in the pipeline (2019-2022) with over 16k total rooms. Homesharing continues to grow representing 18.7% of the total room demand (17% YOY growth).
