



MONTGOMERY HIGH SCHOOL'S 2021 SUMMER S.T.A.Y. PROGRAM *COVID-19 In-Person Supports Consent Form*

Dear Parent/Legal Guardian:

The Sweetwater Union High School District (the "District"), pursuant to direction from the State of California, Centers for Disease Control and San Diego County Public Health Orders, continues to require social distancing, health precautions and restrictions on activities, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In line with these directions, the District has carefully considered which in-person after school programming and the District is inviting, with your consent, your student to receive in-person academic or enrichment programs available in person at Montgomery High School's after school program.

Consistent with state and local public health orders and guidance, to protect your family and the service provider, the District has implemented precautions to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19 in connection with the in-person ASSETs After School Program at Montgomery High School. The District needs your cooperation to ensure the effectiveness of these precautions.

The District's precautions will include the following measures and may be updated to reflect further public health orders and/or guidance:

- District has established safety protocols for student attendance at small group supports in the after school program.
- Before each in-person ASSETs after school program participation, Parent/Guardian will complete a [checklist](#) regarding known or suspected COVID-19 diagnosis or symptoms in self or household prior to in-person supports:
 - If you, the student or another person in your household has a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 within the 14 days prior to the in-person supports and/or has experienced COVID-19 symptoms within the 72 hours prior to the in-person ASSETs after school programming, the student will not be able to participate.
 - Please note that just like general school attendance guidelines, if your student has not been fever free for more than 24 hours, without the assistance of medication, the in-person after school program participation will need to be rescheduled.
 - Upon arrival at school, students will also be asked to confirm they have no symptoms.
- Upon arrival at the site, the District will screen for fever using a no touch thermometer to take the student's temperature prior to in-person after school program participation. If the student is above 100 degrees, the parent/legal guardian will be asked to take the student home.
 - If a parent/guardian is dropping a student off, they will be asked to wait until the student has cleared the pre-screening process (including temperature check) prior to leaving.
 - If students are walking, biking or otherwise getting themselves to school, and they do not clear pre-screening, parents/guardians will be contacted to either approve the student transporting themselves home or having a family member come to pick the student up.
 - Students may return upon completion of a COVID-19 test with a negative result or after a duration of three days (72 hours) without any symptoms, including fever. Fever must have been gone without medication for at least 24 hours.

- Parent/Legal Guardian and student will keep a distance of 6 feet from others and there will be no physical contact with others.
- Service Provider will wear a mask or other appropriate face covering at all times unless in a designated area and further than six feet from another person;
- Parents and Legal Guardian will be required to wear a mask or other face covering at all times (available upon request).
- Students will be required to wear a mask or other face covering at all times, except as directed by staff in a designated area and further than six feet from any other person. Student's failure to maintain their mask at all times will result in their being sent home from the in-person after school program. Please review this requirement with your student prior to in-person support attendance:

- Service Provider, student and parent/guardians will follow safe hygiene and will use alcohol-based hand sanitizer or soap-and-water to wash hands upon entering the facility, following use of bathroom, following eating or drinking or taking a mask break, and as otherwise determined appropriate by the service provider. Please review this requirement with your student prior to in-person support attendance:

 - Please inform staff on this form if your student has an allergy to hand sanitizer so alternative handwashing can be made available.
- District will disinfect surfaces and test materials between in-person supports.
- Parent/Legal Guardian commits to remain near the school site and will provide a phone number should the service provider need to contact the parent/guardian for any reason that may arise or if the student needs to be picked up. Parents/Guardians need to be able to return to site within 15 minutes of receiving a phone call.

If you wish to proceed with the in-person after school program participation at Montgomery High School and comply with protocols, please confirm your consent by signing where indicated below and return the form to the District. Please also review the protocols and rules set forth above with your student and as applicable have them indicate their support for wearing their mask and following other protocols.
