Coming with supplies on the first day of school is the first step towards being an organized student. Carefully follow ALL instructions on the attached Supply List to be organized and prepared for the year. Remember, there will be NO SHARING, or borrowing of any items.

Shopping Instructions:

- Use the check-off column to keep track of items acquired.
- Read the “Item Descriptions” and “Notes” carefully as teachers have provided specific information towards bringing the exact items needed.
- Note that descriptions are not always the same for each teacher. Also, some items are only for certain grades—be sure to check carefully the grades when purchasing.

Shopping Tips:

- Buy extra items which are needed for homework and projects.
- Stock up on items needing to be replaced throughout the year as they’re cheaper during summer.
- Sometimes a better quality will be more cost effective than a cheaper item if it lasts the full year.
- Avoid buying fancy or extra items not on the list as they become a distraction rather than a help.

Labeling:

- Be sure to purchase a permanent marker to label all school supplies and clothing.
- Labeling makes it easier to return lost items to their owners:
 - o Uniform items that are identical for all students
 - o Lunch boxes, binders, consumable books that other students have

Coming Prepared:

- Organize supplies before the first day of school.
- Unwrap all items and put them inside your binder in an organized manner.
- Set up your binder in advance, but wait to label pocket dividers until meeting teachers.
