CAMPUS POLICIES & PROCEDURES

At Premier Academy, we are proud of the school atmosphere we have created to challenge our students and to meet their individual needs. We strive to create a learning climate that encourages student achievement and fosters a positive learning community. However, I'm reaching out to you today to ask for your assistance in helping us address some behavioral and safety concerns that have been occurring over the past couple of months.

Safety and security is one of my top priorities! Upon student's arrival if they possess a book bag, purse, clutch and or wallet it will be searched by Security and/or Administration.

Arrival and Dismissal

School starts at 7:55am and ends 2:00pm. Students are considered tardy after 8:10am, students that arrive after 8:10am must sign in tardy binder located in the front office. Students that arrive after 8:30am will not BE PERMITTED into school.

Students will be dismissed promptly at 2:00pm by teachers and security. Students are to leave campus in an orderly fashion.

Dress Code

Students are to be in school uniform EVERYDAY. Student uniforms consist of the Premier Academy Polo shirt or T-shirt ONLY, with black or khaki pants or shorts.

The following items are prohibited:

- Jeans denim of any kind (jeggings, joggers etc.)
- Flip flops (all shoes must closed toe)
- Head gear of any kind(hats, scarfs, doo-rags, bonnets etc.)

Students that arrive out of uniform or wearing any of the items mentioned above , and out of dress code will NOT BE PERMITTED into school.
