What to do with the parts of the Bible you don't understand: John 5:13-17

- 1. Check if the rest of the Bible offers FURTHER CLARIFICATION.
- 2. Don't confuse your favorite teacher's **OPINION** with a **BIBLE VERSE**.
- 3. Focus on the passages that are **CRYSTAL CLEAR**, not the passages that are **UNCLEAR** and **DIVISIVE**.

- 1. Alignment in what I ASK FOR
- 2. Alignment in how I LIVE

How to pray in alignment with God's will:

1. Represent JESUS


