What is the big deal about a Sabbath Day?

Matthew 12:1-14, Colossians 2:16-17, Deuteronomy 23:25

Sabbath: Genesis 2:1-4, Exodus 16:1-36, 20:8-11, 31:13-17, 35:3, Leviticus 23:3, Deuteronomy 5:12-15, Isaiah 58:13-14

The Sabbath was God's gift to His people to provide rest and restoration **SPIRITUALLY, PHYSICALLY, and RELATIONALLY.**

Jesus never broke God's **LAW**, but rather tore apart man's **LEGALISM**.

Why people are going to hate Jesus:

Matthew 12:1-14

Jesus will only leave us with two options: **SURRENDER TO** Him or **KILL** Him.
