VISIT VACAVILLE RELEASES NEW ADDITIONS TO ARTS WEEK SCHEDULE

Opportunity to watch artists decorating life-sized ceramic cows is on the list

Vacaville, Calif. August 15, 2023 — Visit Vacaville has announced new additions to its fun-filled annual celebration, including the opportunity to watch several life-sized cows be painted, decoupaged and otherwise adorned through a glass window display at the Nut Tree, where artists will be working to ready the cows for unveiling and permanent sculpture placement around town in September. While no schedule is set for the viewings, curious visitors are welcome to stop by and try to spot the art in action from now until Arts Fest opens.

Other additions to this year's schedule include a history of winemaking exhibit at Vacaville Museum, a city-sponsored painting event on Main Street, and an Oktoberfest celebration downtown. Visit Vacaville's main event will happen on September 23. On stage performances will take place every half hour at Vacaville Performing Arts Theatre, while outside in the Ulatis Community Center courtyard and plaza, participants can enjoy musicians, art vendors, art classes, a community paint by number mural, and an art sculpture building project made with canned goods that will be donated after the event.

"This year's festival includes a huge array of art forms, exhibits, and hands-on activities," said Melyssa Reeves, Visit Vacaville President & CEO. "There is truly something to capture any interest, whether you want to watch a performance, participate in community art, or try a new medium on your own. It's a huge undertaking, brought together with the help of amazing community partners, and we can't wait to kick the event off."
