In FY 2020, Valley Water awarded the Children's Discovery Museum (Grantee) a \$5,000 Safe, Clean Water Program D3 Mini-Grant for their Project Transect Alamitos Project (Project). Grantee planned to expand the scope of its existing Students Investigating Their Environment (BioSITE) environmental education program for the 4th-grade students of Graystone and Williams Elementary Schools and their Leland High School student mentors. Grantee could not carry out the Project with the students due to impacts from the COVID-19 pandemic and the Santa Clara County health mandates that required all inperson programs to be canceled. The grant activities were not conducive to a virtual program. Grantee requested to cancel the mini-grant via email on May 3, 2022, which is attached for your reference.

Please note that the grant project closeout/cancellation is an internal process and the timeline between when final documentations are submitted and when the project is closed out/cancelled, does not impact the grantee, as it is processed after the final payment is issued to the grantee. Staff prioritizes tasks that directly impact the grantees, such as invoice processing, agreement and amendment execution, application review, etc. As a result, grant project closeouts/cancellations may have a longer timeline, but this timeline does not have any impact on grantees.
