

## HOW TO FIND YOUR Planning jurisdiction

Follow the instructions below to determine if your property is in Wake County's jurisdiction.

## **OPTION** 1

Search by Address, PIN, Owner or Real Estate ID

## 1. Open iMAPS

 Search for the property on iMAPS in the upper right hand corner (by Address, PIN, Owner or Real Estate ID).



**Tip:** Use a partial address if the full address is not returning any results.

**3.** When your property has been found, scroll down under the General information and check to see if "Wake County" is listed as the Jurisdiction.



Note: If it says "Wake County," you are looking in the correct place for regulations. If it is another jurisdiction, you will need to contact your municipal planning department for more information.


## **OPTION 2**

Search by Manually Locating Your Property on the Map

- 1. Open iMAPS
- 2. Find your property on the map and double-click.



**3.** Check to see if "WC" (Wake County) is listed as the Planning Jurisdiction on the pop-up box under General.



**Note:** If it says "WC" you are looking in the correct place for regulations. If it is another jurisdiction, you will need to contact your municipal planning department for more information.
