









Mean Time for Patients with Confirmed STEMI; Combined for All Hospitals








EMS Stroke Evidence Based Medicine Measures Patients Transported by EMS with Suspected or Confirmed Stroke




Code Strokes by EMS taken to Wake County Hospitals




Hospital DCDx Stroke that did not Receive tPA or Intervention




All Hospitals 1st Qtr 2018 Outcomes for Wake EMS Stroke Patients who Received tPA



All Hospitals 1st Qtr 2018 Wake EMS Stroke Patients who Received tPA Symptom Improvement




All Hospitals 1st Qtr 2018 Wake EMS Stroke Patients who Received tPA ICH Post Administration










Wake EMS System Penetrating Trauma Scene Times











Wake EMS Worked Cardiac Arrest













Wake EMS System CPAP Application Time










Wake EMS Patients who received Vasotec for CHF; Pre/Post Systolic Blood Pressure 3rd Qtr 2017










Wake EMS System Seizure Patients Treated with Versed










Medications Administered by First Responders – Derived from EMS Documentation




