#### **New CAD**



- Formerly known as Tri-Tech CAD
- Demonstrated ability to perform in high-volume, multi-discipline, multi-agency environments
- Integrated CAD and mapping function into a single application on the MDT

# What are the Improvements?

- Dynamic rostering of each unit - including names and Radio ID#s
- Utilization of GPS technology to send the most appropriate unit automatically through repolling
- Enhanced visualization of coresponders on the MDT
- Enhance unit statuses to match operational needs

- Ability to auto dispatch calls
- Automate the process of move ups and cover assignments with a tested logic for all responders
- Interface with the Cary PSAP CAD system
- Notify units of high-acuity events nearby
- Engage the community during cardiac arrests
- Apply rules within geofencing and auto-status.


# **Emerging Technology**

# May 13<sup>th</sup> Tornado

- Impact: 7-8 mile of damage from about Davistown
   Rd in Wendell through the Zebulon Industrial Park.
- Regional Unified Command Post at Wendell FD for east side of county. Also had a just in time DOC open at the Shift Commanders office.
- Second band of severe thunderstorms through south and east part of the Wake County.





#### **Dreamville Festival**

- DDH Campus
  - 308 acre site
  - Multi-stage built venue
- April 6, 2019
  - 1200-2300 (until it clears out)
- Attendance: Sold out at 40,000
- Expected challenges
  - Unknowns with new venue,
  - Parking (downtown decks),
  - Pedestrian/scooter traffic from DDH to downtown,
  - Alcohol (liquor bars with big cost),
  - Saturday night with event ending with crowds surging into downtown.



## **Dreamville Festival**

#### Ticketing Data:

- Attendees traveled to Raleigh from all 50 states
- 12 international countries including United Arab, Emirates, Australia, Serbia, and the UK
- Raleigh, Durham, and Chapel Hill accounted for just 18% of ticket sales

Friday: 90.5% up 18.5%

Saturday: 96.6% up 19%

#### **Rooms Sold:**

Friday: up 22.4%

# **EMS** Response

#### • EMS Response:

- 411 Requests for assistance
- 103 Refusals
- 8 Transports
- Staffed with several venue foot teams, transport units, medical tents, cart teams, physicians, command staff across 48 acres.
  - Mutual aid (sub-contract) to 4 surrounding counties and CapRAC MRC using a regional approach
    - Durham, Orange, Johnston, and Franklin
  - Significant MCI plan.

January – April 2019


- 35,321 incidents

- Increase of 6 calls per day from 2018


# Low System Resources (ESTAT) Update

#### **ESTAT**


#### January-April 2019

  - Longest duration just over 4 hours.





#### ESTAT PER MONTH LAST 12 MONTHS




