### AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN

## WAKE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF RALEIGH REGARDING

IMPLEMENTATION OF COUNTYWIDE ROOM OCCUPANCY AND PREPARED FOOD AND BEVERAGE TAX

This agreement entered into this day of <u>vertextex</u>, 1992, by and between the County of Wake, North Carolina (hereinafter referred to as the County) and the City of Raleigh, North Carolina (hereinafter referred to as the City) pursuant to the provisions of Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, and in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 594 of the 1991 Session Laws of North Carolina (hereinafter referred to as the Enabling Act).

#### WITNESSETH

Whereas, Wake County and the City of Raleigh entered into an Interlocal Agreement on November 19, 1991, pursuant to the Enabling Act concerning the capital projects to be funded by the proceeds of prepared food and beverage tax and room occupancy tax; and

Whereas, the Interlocal Agreement identifies the following projects among others to be funded by the aforementioned tax proceeds:

- a. renovations to existing Raleigh Civic Center
- b. purchase of land for new Convention Center
- c. construction of new Convention Center, and
- d. construction of Triangle Central Park sports facility

Whereas, it is recognized as necessary to revise and amend the Interlocal Agreement from time to time accounting for changing conditions affecting the development of capital projects funded under the Enabling Act; and

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the County and the City agree to the following amendments to the Interlocal Agreement:

1. Paragraph 5 of the Agreement shall be amended by deleting the last sentence thereof and substituting therefore the following:

"In the event the actual undesignated proceeds are greater than estimated, the excess shall be distributed as follows:

- A. The first \$250,000 of such excess funds shall be distributed to any of the projects designated in Paragraph 4 of this Agreement, in the sole discretion of the City;
- B. The next \$250,000 of such excess funds shall be distributed to any of the projects designated in Paragraph 4 of this Agreement, in the sole discretion of the County; and

- C. Any such excess funds over \$500,000 shall be retained in the Future Projects Reserve Fund."
- 2. Paragraph 7 of the Agreement shall be amended to read as follows:

"Funds accumulated in the Renovations of Existing Civic Center Reserve Fund shall be distributed to the City for said renovations as required to make payments due for work performed pursuant to a construction schedule adopted by the City."

3. Paragraph 8 of said Agreement shall be amended to read as follows:

"The City and the County recognize that the success of the Convention Center project is directly related to the construction of additional hotel rooms within walking distance of the project. Accordingly, the City and County will work with the Greater Raleigh Chamber of Commerce to secure commitments from private sources for the construction of approximately 700 additional hotel rooms within walking distance of the project. The City shall obtain, by method of its choice, the financing necessary to construct the facility, and the proceeds of the Convention Center Construction Reserve Fund may be used to assist in the debt service. It is anticipated that the new Convention Center will be completed within three years after financing for the facility is obtained. It is anticipated that the land upon which the new Convention Center will be located will be purchased by July of 1997. Land purchased for said project shall be owned by the City; however, any proceeds realized from the use of the land prior to commitment of construction for the Convention Center shall be retained in the Convention Center Construction Fund."

4. A new paragraph, designated as Paragraph 10.1, shall be added and shall read as follows:

"In the event the voters of the City, in November of 1992, approve a General Obligation Bond issue in the amount of \$95,000,000 to finance the construction of the Convention Center, the County and the City agree to amend this Agreement to provide that funds designated for the Triangle Central Park facility will be transferred to the Convention Center Construction Fund."

5. A new paragraph, designated at Paragraph 16.1, shall be added to said Agreement and shall read as follows:

"The County shall be primarily responsible for the Children's Museum project, and the City shall be primarily responsible for the renovations to the existing Raleigh Civic Center project, purchase of land for the new Convention Center project, construction of a new Civic Center project and purchase of land for a new Performing Arts Center project."

"The County and City jointly, along with other principal agencies, shall be responsible for the Centennial Center project."

6. Except as amended herein, the provisions of said Interlocal Agreement are hereby ratified and remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Agreement is executed the day and year first above written pursuant to resolution adopted by the governing boards of the County and City.
