When we enter the park office, we might see park staff at the front desk. They can give us information about Crowder and answer questions about our visit.

Sometimes the office may be closed because staff are out working in a different part of the park. If no one is at the front office, we can take a brochure from outside the building and begin our tour.

We can pick up a brochure which has information and a map of the park. This will help us plan where we will go and what we will see.

If I designed a My Crowder Park tour before our visit, I can follow my checklist. I can also change my tour and choose to see different things.

If I haven't designed a My Crowder Park tour before my visit, I can create my own using the My Crowder Park Pack, which I can check out from the Discovery Box bin located outside of the park's office.

Sometimes parts of the park can get crowded and noisy, but there are always quiet spots to explore. My family can read about <u>Tips for a Successful Visit</u> on the website so we know about these places ahead of time. These tips are also available inside of the My Crowder Park Pack's binder.

If it is too noisy, I can ask for head phones to muffle the noise. I can also ask for toys if I need something to do with my hands. These are in the My Crowder Park Pack, which can be borrowed from the Discovery Box bin outside of the park's office.



If I need a break or want to leave, I will tell the adult I am with.
