Consolidation of Wake County EMS

- Single 911 EMS provider in Wake County effective May 3, 2021.
 - Cary April 1, 2021
 - Eastern Wake EMS May 3, 2021
- All personnel have been offered positions with Wake County EMS and many have transitioned over.
- Same number of units and level of service in already existing locations.
 - New location for Cary Main and Zebulon



COVID response

- Use of the 36-card suspended on May 5, 2021
 - Return to normal operations
 - Use of EIDS on all calls
 - Questions modified



Vaccination by the numbers

- County vaccination sites have administered over 200,000 vaccines since 12/14/2020
- Together, all partners have administered 1,030,256 doses (1st and 2nd dose combined)
- EMS has been instrumental at the PNC clinic (Mission Complete: 5/12)
 - Staffing the Operations Section Chief, Vaccine Group Supervisor, Registration Group Supervisor, and Recovery lot.
- PNC clinic has completed over 85,000 vaccines
 - 8.2% of all vaccinations countywide!




Colonial Pipeline Impact

- Monitoring closely for systemic challenges to ensure continuity of operations:
 - Keeping EMS units fueled
 - Monitoring for hospital surge due to discharge delays resulting in long turnaround time.
 - Building contingencies for employees unable to get to work or needing temporary modifications to assignment.

- 27,654 incidents in 1Q2021
- April 2021 busiest month on record 9,661 incidents
 - Average 322 calls per day
 - (only 4 days with volume under 300 calls/day)




Hospital Diversion 1Q2021

Red Diversion 1Q2021




Yellow Diversion 1Q2021













Hospital Times


