Organizational Structure



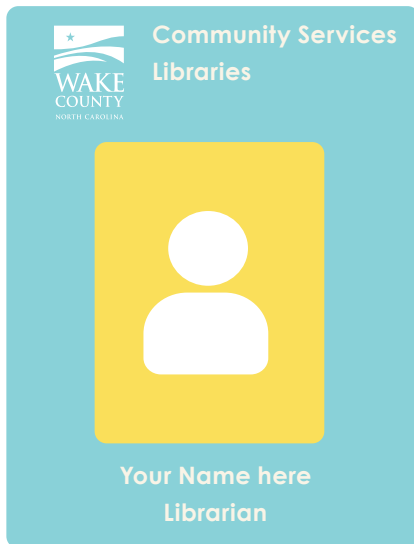
