






Mean Time for Patients with Confirmed STEMI; Combined for All Hospitals

STEMIs activated by EMS: 60








EMS Stroke Evidence Based Medicine Measures Patients Transported by EMS with Suspected or Confirmed Stroke










Transports By Facility






Wake EMS Worked Cardiac Arrest









APP Alternate Destination Screening



Successful APP Alternate Destination %




3rd Quarter 2022 Alternate Destination Reason for ED Transport






Wake EMS System Penetrating Trauma Scene Times




Wake EMS System CPAP Application Time




Wake EMS System Intubation Prevented with CPAP




Wake EMS System Seizure Patients Treated with Versed




Medications Administered by First Responders – Derived from EMS Documentation






