Wake Co WIC breastfeeding (BF) support is available to pregnant & breastfeeding mothers enrolled in the Wake Co WIC Program. Women referred but not enrolled in WIC are called and provided information on enrolling in the program to receive BF support, including contacts by phone, in WIC clinic, or postpartum home visits by appointment.

WIC BF support is targeted to a mother's current situation; the most effective support may be information or techniques not requiring a pump. Determination for pump issuance requires postpartum assessment by qualified WIC staff to assess current breastfeeding status. Pump issuance includes required teaching on pump assembly, use, cleaning, & troubleshooting; pumped milk storage guidelines; & other relevant aspects.
