# 2025 Application



The Sheila B. Jones Environmental Education Scholarship, offered by the **Friends of the Wake Soil and Water Conservation District**, supports students who are pursuing a career in environmental education (EE), especially those who have faced financial or other barriers. This scholarship honors the legacy of Sheila B. Jones, retired environmental educator who made a big difference in the field in her career working for the Wake Soil and Water Conservation District.

One student will receive a <u>one-time \$1,000 scholarship</u>. Applicants are encouraged to demonstrate their deep passion for environmental education, a clear vision of their career goals, and a genuine need for financial support to pursue their educational aspirations.

### **Eligibility:**

- High school seniors in a Wake County school who have been accepted into a college and are planning to pursue a career in environmental education
- Current college students in NC colleges with residence in Wake County who are actively pursuing a career in environmental education
- Past applicants may re-apply, but not past award recipients.

### **Required application materials:**

- □ Information forms (pages 2-5 of this document)
- □ Transcript(s)
- One letter of recommendation
- □ Essay (400-500 words)

The 2025 application period opens on January 17, and closes on April 17 at 5:00 pm
