Sealed proposals will be received by Wake County Procurement Services, in Suite 2900, Wake County Justice Center, 301 McDowell Street, Raleigh, NC 27601, up to **3:00 p.m., March 18, 2025**, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read for providing labor, material and equipment entering into the construction of the South Wake Landfill Air Compressor and Modular Housing Unit, located in Apex, NC. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Installation of the new air compressor system and associated piping, fittings, and electrical components in a modular housing unit, and new below grade air conveyance piping and associated fittings to connect the air compressor system to the existing air piping network. Durations of LFG system shutdowns during this project shall be limited to no more than 6 hours within any 24-hour period.

Wake County provides minorities and women equal opportunity to participate in all aspects of its construction program consistent with NCGS §143-8. Bidders shall comply with the requirements of the Wake County Minority Business Enterprise Program, as outlined in Section 00 73 39 of the Project Manual.

No bid may be withdrawn for sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for bids.
