## How Does it Work? (i)

- Throughout the school year, teams of 3-5 students in middle school (grades 5-8) and high school (grades 9-12) study the online curriculum on environmental science and natural resources management.
- In the spring, teams take written tests on the content and must also demonstrate mastery of practical skills in the 5 subject areas.
- The regional contest (Area 4) will be March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026, and the top 7 middle and high school teams qualify for the state competition which will take place on April 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup>!

# Who Can Participate? 👸

Students in grades 5-12 can form teams from the same organization, such as:

- School science clubs
- Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts
- FFA
- 4-H
- Homeschool groups

An adult team advisor (teacher, parent, youth leader, etc.) is **required** for students to participate.
