How Does it Work? ⓘ

- ➔ Throughout the school year, teams of 3-5 students in middle school (grades 5-8) and high school (grades 9-12) study the online curriculum on environmental science and natural resources management.
- ➔ In the spring, teams take written tests on the content and must also demonstrate mastery of practical skills in the 5 subject areas.
- ➔ The regional contest (Area 4) will be March 19th, 2026, and the top 7 middle and high school teams qualify for the state competition which will take place on April 24th & 25th!
