Dear Wake County Property Owner,

According to Wake County records, the septic system serving your property is a Type IIIb with a wastewater pump. This type of system requires inspection every five years by the county.

Wake County Onsite Water Protection staff will be visiting your property at **Property Address** in the next one to twelve weeks to inspect your system. This is a no-cost inspection that checks your system's tank, pump components and drain field to ensure they are functioning properly. If you own this property as rental property, please contact your tenant and inform the tenant that the septic system serving this property will be inspected by a representative from Wake County in the coming weeks.

These inspections are required by state law under the "Rules Governing Sewage Treatment and Disposal Systems" (15A NCAC 18E section 1300). Our goal is to assist you and detect any issues before they worsen. Following the visit, we will send you a detailed report via email or regular mail to review any problems or concerns.

You do not have to be home for the inspection to occur. If your property requires special accommodations (pets in yard, locked gates, etc.) to access the septic system components or if you would like to schedule an inspection appointment, please contact us at OMcontact@wake.gov.
