Wake County Parks, Recreation and Open Space Park Aide – Boat Rental

Work Location: Lake Crabtree County Park, 1400 Aviation Parkway, Morrisville, NC 27560

Pay: \$20.10 per hour; about ~20 hours/ week

This is a seasonal position that will begin in Mid-May and end at Labor Day.

This position has a yearly 1000-hour cap. This position is not eligible for benefits.

Primary Duties: Boat rental staff will be responsible for providing exceptional customer service to the general public and organized groups. Primary duties include, but are not limited to, the following: rent boats, track boat rentals using Microsoft excel, maintain rental fleet as needed, patrol the lake and enforce rules, monitor weather, provide instruction to renters, clean up and break down equipment and boats on the rental beach. Applicants should be prepared to work in high heat and inclement weather.

Secondary Duties: Provide assistance where needed such as patrolling the park, cleaning litter and changing trash. Staff may be asked to assist in minor landscaping duties and programs as well.

Qualifications:

Required: Applicant must be at least 18 years old and have a valid NC driver's license. A "safe driving record" and background check are required for the position.

Preferred: One-year experience in a park setting working in operations and customer service or equivalent. Boating experience is desirable. Applicant will be trained in Basic First Aid and CPR certification after being hired. Applicant will be required to obtain an NC Boating Certificate once hired.

Typical workdays are 8 hr. shifts with 30-minute lunch break. A standard boat rental shift lasts from **9:30 am to 6:00 pm Friday - Sunday**. Boat Rental staff may be asked to assist in programs and YMCA boating days. Position hours are between 16-24 hours per week. Boat rental applicants should be prepared to work most weekends and most summer holidays. Monthly work schedule provided. This is a perfect introductory position for those wishing practical, on-the-job park and boating experience and career exploration!
