Sample Ballot Key & Combined Sample Ballots

- ✓ Election Day ballots are assigned to the specific precinct that coincides with the voter's election districts.
- ✓ Voters affiliated with any political party may vote the ballot of candidates for their party only. Please note that the Green Party and Libertarian Party do not have primary ballots for the March Election.
- ✓ Unaffiliated voters may choose to vote any one political party's ballot. A voter cannot vote in more than one party's primary.
- ✓ To be eligible to vote in the City of Raleigh Municipal Primary Election, you must be registered to vote and live within the municipal city limits. ONLY City of Raleigh voters will have a non-partisan ballot option.
