Tiny Tots: *Corduroy*

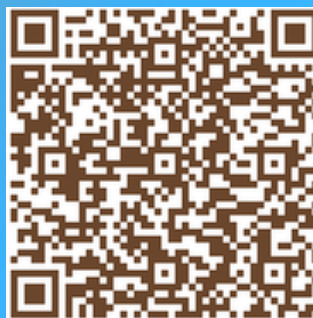
Monday, June 15, 10:15-11 am
