Lisa Booze and Billy Lee led a tour of downtown Cary GSI projects that demonstrate how projects can achieve multiple benefits across One Water focus areas. Through a three pronged approach that includes retrofits, public-private partnerships, and GSI grant funding for property owners, Cary demonstrated how GSI projects provide water quality benefits, flood resilience and serve as community amenities. Project stops included: 1) Ivy Ellington House, 2) Regional stormwater wetland, 3) Downtown Cary Park and 4) Byrum Street developments.

Following the tour, Water Partnership members met at the Downtown Cary Park pavilion to review action strategies and answer questions associated with the One Water Plan. Chair Wiebke communicated the importance of being prepared for the August Water Partnership meeting by reviewing the proposed revisions to the Rules of Procedure and identifying priority areas for action. Committee members provided input on priorities including outreach, metrics, policy and topic-specific task forces/workgroups associated with Wake One Water Focus Areas. The Committee also highlighted opportunities to engage younger workforce in organizations and through collaboration with local universities. Chair Wiebke reiterated the need for Water Partnership members to hold each other accountable as the group works to take action on identified priorities.
